1. $3x - y = 7$

$2x + y = 3$

2. $-x + 2y = 2$

$x + 4y = 10$

3. $2x - y = 12$

$3x + 2y = -3$

4. $5x - 3y = -20$

$-3x + 6y = 12$

5. $4x + 3y = 10$

$-8x - 6y = -48$

6. $4x - 3y = -19$

$3x + 2y = 24$

7. $2x + 3y = -15$

$5x + 2y = 1$

8. $6x + 7y = 4$

$5x + 8y = -1$

9. $4x - 6y = 10$

$-10x + 15y = -25$

For each of the following please classify whether the systems of equations are Consistent and Independent, Consistent and Dependent, or Inconsistent and whether each system has One Solution, No Solutions, or an Infinite number of Solutions. State your answer; if your answer is Consistent and Independent and has One solution, please solve and give me the one solution.

10. $8x - 4y = 24$

$12x - 6y = 24$

11. $-6x + 24y = -48$

$3x - 12y = 24$

12. $-6x + 3y = -12$

$16x + 4y = 8$

13. $12x - 12y = -36$

$-16x + 8y = 8$

14. $-4x - 6y = -36$

$-8x - 12y = 48$

15. $6x + 3y = -18$
